What a wonderful week we had last week, celebrating world Book Day together.



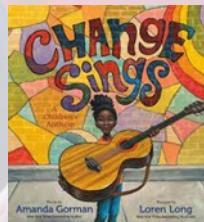
The children were all very excited about reading and are busy making lots of improvements to our reading areas in school with their teachers.

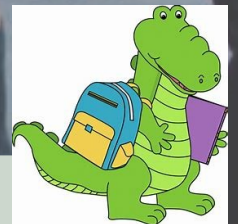
