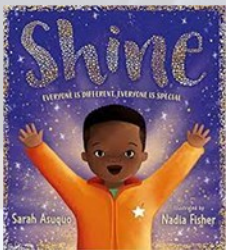
### World Book Week

This week I would like to recommend the following books for you to consider reading with your child or maybe encouraging your child to read.

"Shine" is a picture book that tells the story of a young boy named Kai who struggles with feeling different due to his height and a facial scar, causing him to be bullied at school; with the support of his parents, Kai learns to embrace his unique qualities and realize that everyone has a special "shine" within them, making their differences a source of strength and beauty, encouraging readers to celebrate diversity and self-acceptance. " I would recommend this book to all children as it stimulates much needed conversation about how special all children are and how important it is that we see the beauty inside everyone else.

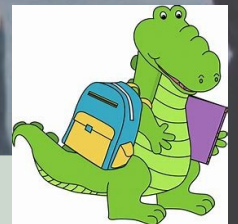
