## Living Well Together

Dear Parents and Carers,

In today's digital world, our children have access to an enormous amount of information, communication tools, and online spaces – many of which are not designed with their safety in mind. This is why setting strong parental controls on your child's phones, tablets, and computers is more important than ever. Parental controls help limit exposure to inappropriate content, prevent accidental access to harmful websites, and restrict features that could put them at risk. However, technology alone is not enough. It's equally important to regularly check your child's devices, including their chats, apps, and online interactions. Children can sometimes be unaware of the risks, overly trusting, or unsure of how to handle uncomfortable situations online.

Without supervision, children may be exposed to several dangers, including:

Online predators who often hide behind fake profiles

Cyberbullying, which can occur through messaging apps, games, and social media

Inappropriate content that they may stumble across or be sent by others

Scams and phishing attempts that can trick them into sharing personal information

Excessive screen-time or access to adult apps and services

By staying actively involved in your child's online life, setting boundaries, checking devices, and having open conversations you play a crucial role in protecting their wellbeing and helping them develop healthy digital habits.
