Dear Parents and Carers,

We'd like to gently remind everyone that our school gates open at 8:40am, giving children plenty of time to settle into class before learning begins at 8:55am. Arriving during this window helps children start their day calmly and confidently. We understand that mornings don't always go to plan, and unexpected situations can happen, but we really appreciate your efforts in helping children arrive on time whenever possible. Being on time supports their attendance and helps them feel ready for the day ahead.

We also want to share a reminder about collection times. The school day finishes at 3:30pm, and we ask that all children are collected promptly. After this time, staff are busy preparing for the next day, attending meetings, or running clubs, and are not available for supervision. Of course, we understand that genuine emergencies do arise, and in those situations we will always make sure your child is safe. We simply ask that regular collection happens at 3:30pm so children can finish their day smoothly and confidently.

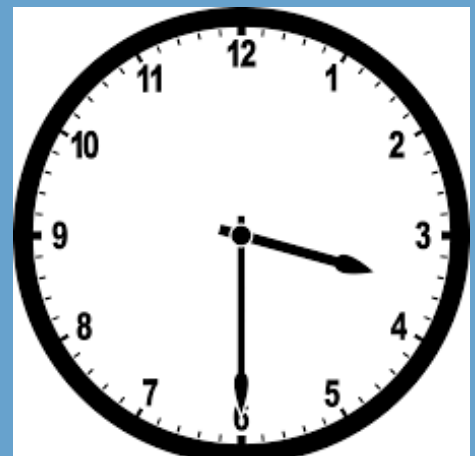
Thank you for your continued support in helping our school days run happily and safely for all our children.
