Welcome back! We hope you all had a wonderful restful week.

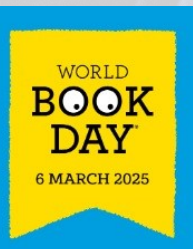


Year 1 and 2 Rand Farm Residential

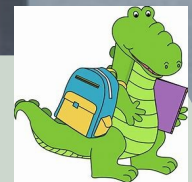
